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**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN**  
**SOUTH SEVENTH STREET & WEST WASHINGTON STREET INTERSECTION**  
**MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 21 TO APPROXIMATELY SEPTEMBER 24**

**Location and Limits of Affected Area:**

South Seventh Street & West Washington Street Intersection

**Description of Construction:**

The City of Ann Arbor will be constructing a pedestrian crossing island on South Seventh Street immediately south of the West Washington Street intersection, as well as reconstructing sidewalk ramps at the intersection to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements.

**Temporary Construction Traffic Control Plan:**

Beginning September 21 (weather permitting) the intersection of South Seventh Street and West Washington Street will be closed for approximately 3 to 4 days.

During the weeks leading up to the full closure of the intersection, work will be performed at the intersection with traffic being flagged through as necessary. During this time, intermittent closures will occur on Washington Street, with traffic on Seventh Street being maintained.

During the full closure of the intersection, traffic will be detoured as follows:

*Southbound traffic on Seventh Street* will be detoured east at Huron Street, south on First Street, and west on Liberty Street, back to Seventh Street.

*Northbound traffic on Seventh Street* will be detoured east at Liberty Street, north on Ashley Street, and west on Huron Street, back to Seventh Street.

*Eastbound traffic on Washington Street* will be detoured south at Eighth Street, east on Liberty Street, and north on Third Street, back to Washington Street.

*Westbound traffic on Washington Street* will be detoured south at Third Street, west on Liberty Street, and north on Eighth Street, back to Washington Street.

Access will be maintained to all local residences during construction. Pedestrian traffic will be detoured around the intersection as needed. Refer to the enclosed map for further details.
